THE FORGE

Located 2 miles from Bellaghy

Before becoming a forge, this was the first schoolhouse in the Castledawson area. This blacksmith's cottage is in its original state (late 18th/early 19th century).

One half of the building comprises the dwelling area and the other half is where the forge was. The forge has been in the Devlin family for generations and all of the blacksmith's tools, bellows etc are in place, together with various farming implements left in for repair.

The forge has been the subject of a poem written by Seamus Heaney.
