BALL'S GROVE GATE.

This was the former entrance arch to Ball's Grove house. Today, this fine arch may be seen along the northern section of the Drogheda By Pass. It is a very handsome pedimented arch having a central carriage gate flanked by arch pedestrian gates, circular niches over them, wrought-iron gates and a lantern bracket. The gate also contains the coat of arms of the Ball family who were in Drogheda from medieval times; the arch is also dated to the year 1801.
