Decorative stonework on the building formally owned by P. Coman, James Street Tipperary, is believed to have been the work of Joseph K. Bracken. Originally from Templemore, he moved his stonework business to Tipperary to avail of the more extensive building opportunities within the Town. He is now more famous as one of the founding fathers of the Gaelic Athletic Association in Thurles in 1884.
