FOOTBRIDGE

Tipperary Town Railway Station was built by the Waterford and Limerick Railway Company in 1849. The iron foot-bridge was added later to accommodate the increased volume of pedestrian traffic between the military barracks and the town. The company erected similar bridges on the line at nearby Limerick Junction and Clonmel.
