### TIMBER-FRAME HOUSE

Located at Dillon Street, Tipperary, this timber-framed building is one of the few surviving examples of a large number of such houses originally built to accommodate families evicted from their homes during the Plan of Campaign in 1889/90. The method of construction was unusual, consisting of nine inch blocks clad with timber boarding in front and with timber sheeting to the rear. Financial assistance for the project was mainly sourced overseas, with local people providing voluntary labour for the construction work.
