THE WATER TOWER

Little now remains of the extensive buildings that once comprised Tipperary Military Barracks. Erected during the 1870's, the complex was largely destroyed by fire on the night of July 16th, 1922 at the height of the civil war. Still standing, however is this unusual well-built limestone structure, which served as a water tower. It is now located within the grounds of Sean Tracy GAA Park.
